

## **Maryland Green Registry**

The <u>Maryland Green Registry</u> is "a free, voluntary program offering tips and resources to help businesses and other organizations set and meet their own goals on the path to sustainability." Members, who may be communities or individual businesses, complete a public profile to share environmental best practices with each other and the public. The Registry is a free, flexible way for the Town to promote our sustainable businesses as well as its own sustainability actions. Members must reapply every three years.

The Town of Riverdale Park first joined the Maryland Green Registry in 2014. Per the Registry's membership requirements, the Town updated their profile after three years in 2017, and has again in June 2020. The updated submission includes recent items such as the 2019 Earth Day Community Cleanup and recent retrofits to use LEDs in Town streetlights. The Town is also promoting the Registry by reaching out to the Riverdale Park Business Association, which will publicize the Registry to its members in an upcoming issue of its internal publication, *The Biz*, as a way to publicly promote its member businesses and their sustainable actions.
