

Art Wraps

In 2017, the Town of Riverdale Park (TRP) installed five vinyl art wraps to prevent graffiti on traffic control boxes. In collaboration with the City of Hyattsville, TRP has contracted for the placement of four more additional vinyl art wraps by 2020. For these new locations, TRP is soliciting artists to submit proposals with the theme of sustainability. There are at least 20 more installations planned to complete the project.


Public Art

In 2015, the Town of Riverdale Park established a Public Art Initiative and in partnership with the Community Development Corporation (HYCDC), created a rotating, year-round outdoor, town-wide sculpture gallery to bring public artwork to the Town, its residents and its visitors.

The process for this project included a budget of \$11,000 and the release of a request for proposal to area artists. TRP's Director of Developmental Services, two of the town's Councilmembers (David Lingua, Ward 3 and Marsha Dixon, Ward 1) and other volunteers served on the selection committee. The committee members ranked the artists' submissions and reached consensus to select the finalists. The HYCDC maintains the art installations.
