- **Stormwater (MS4)** – Hear from the County and Phase II jurisdictions on their progress including the status of the County's new permit and new approaches DEP is rolling out to reduce stormwater.
- **Climate Change and Resiliency** – Hear about the current progress on climate change and resiliency from the County and the City of Rockville. Learn how you can get involved.
- **Pesticide Law** – Learn more about the County pesticide law and how it is being implemented including other jurisdictions that are adopting the law.
- **Litter Issues** – Local experts will be on hand to discuss litter issues facing the County and plans to combat them.
